**Instructions and Conditions for an  
Application for Collection of Derelict Vehicles**

1. Please fill in entire application, including serial number, for each vehicle to be collected.
2. Return your completed application to: Public Works Department, Municipality of the District of Chester, 151 King Street, PO Box 369, Chester, Nova Scotia B0J 1J0. If you have any questions call (902) 275-1312.
3. If approved, the application will be forwarded to the Contractor and the vehicle(s) will be collected within two weeks. If not approved, you will be contacted.

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**CONDITIONS**

1. The Derelict Vehicle program is free to participants.
2. The Contractor will not collect car parts unless they are contained within a vehicle. For example, a transmission or fender, etc. may be placed inside a derelict vehicle for collection; however, those parts will not be collected by themselves.
3. A derelict vehicle will not be collected if household garbage is placed inside.
4. The Contractor will take a maximum of five (5) tires with the derelict vehicle to be collected.
5. Derelict vehicles must be accessible to the Contractor and removal equipment.
6. A maximum of five (5) derelict vehicles will be collected; however, more vehicles can be removed through special arrangement. Special arrangements can be made through the Public Works Department, (902) 275-1312.
